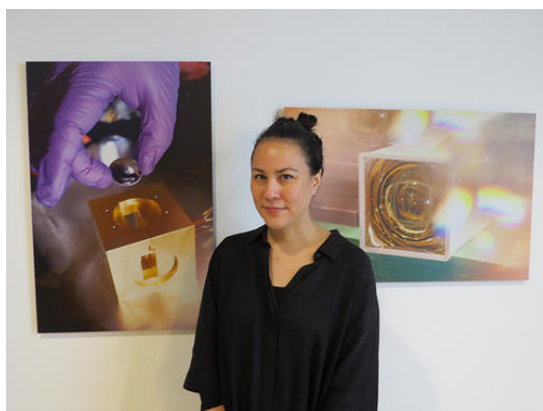

Wright Lab featured in photographic exhibition at the Yale Center for Collaborative Arts and Media (CCAM) through November 22

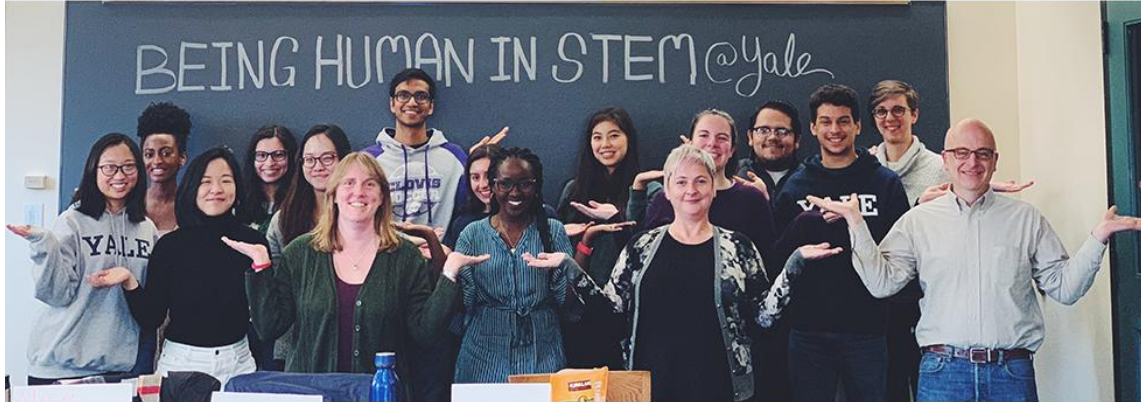
